Trusting God February 13, 2011 Substitute Teacher, Barry Asmus

Before we were Christians, there were a billion stories of life without Christ. Egocentric, my desires, my pleasures, my happiness, my control, my success, my needs - - - resist authority, willful rebellion, obsessions, compulsions, addictions, sinfulness - - - I, I, me, me - - - what about me? But in all that we sometimes heard a quite song in the background of our lives – "Amazing Grace, how sweet the sound, that saved a wretch like me"...

And finally we saw the light: Born again, forgiveness, trusting Christ for our salvation. For by grace are you saved thru faith. When the <u>Infinite</u> slipped into the bloodstream of human history, the world would never be the same again. You mean infinite like omniscient? Infinite like omnipresent? Infinite like omnipotent? You mean infinite like Ps. 139 - - He knows me - - He loves me - - He thinks about me constantly?

When the earth became the visited planet, "The world became flesh and dwelled among us", God's continuing story became a never ending one: a birth, a death, and a resurrection - - a solitary life who changed the world.

So now we want to please God - - church, fellowship, worship, generosity, obey commandments, love our neighbor, evangelize, work hard, etc. While we all believe that salvation is an underserved gift, unmerited and unearned, many of us think that living a good Christian life takes some doing on our part: good works, striving, and effort that depends in part on our giftedness and moral goodness. Our primary motive is to please God with our best efforts. In all that we sometimes miss the scripture that says without faith it is impossible to please God; that trusting comes first; that pleasing God is actually a product of faith and trusting God.

Salvation – Trusting God – where grace saves us from the penalty of sin.

Sanctification (living the Christian life) – Trusting God – where <u>grace</u> saves us from the power of sin (only by grace can we say "no") and finally,

Glorification – Trusting God - where grace saves us from the presence of sin (Heaven is indeed a wonderful place)

For by grace are you saved, sanctified, and glorified. God does it all. Through faith, we trust, and that pleases God immensely.

How does taking the "trust" path happen? Often the catalyst is difficulty.

Trials, tribulations, and adversity are frequently God's greatest benedictions, blessings in disguise, angels dressed in black but for a moment. Often the things we think will break us are actually the things that make us.
